



## LIENHART-MINNICK SCHOLARSHIP

**General Information:** Scholarship recipients must have demonstrated a proven record of superior academic performance in high school, an outstanding record of school or other pre-college leadership and clear potential for success in the rigorous intellectual campus environment of The College. A combination of ACT, SAT, or equivalent aptitude scores and high school grades must place the applicant in the top 5% of their high school class.

**Application Procedure:** Applicant must be from an Idaho high school and entering The College as a freshman. Student submits a one-page essay outlining his/her goals for the future. Give the essay and this form to a high school principal or counselor. The principal or counselor needs to attach a letter of recommendation and send the essay and application to The College of Idaho Office of Student Financial Aid Services.

**Notification Date:** Notification to award recipients will begin in April and continue until all funds are allocated.
