

The following steps illustrate how to connect to a network drive when using Windows Vista:

1. First, ensure that you are connected to the network.
2. Click on the start button.
3. On the Start Menu, right-click My Computer and select Map Network Drive
4. Select what letter you want the network drive to be named in this example, we will select P:
5. Under Folder: type in the path of the network drive you wish to access. The path of the public drive is [\\coyote\public](#) -- The path of your private drive will be [\\athena\firstname.lastname\\$](#)
6. Make sure that the Reconnect at logon box is checked.
7. Click Connect using a different user name.
8. Under User name: type in Campus\yourusername , then put your password in the corresponding box. Click Okay.
9. Click Finish. Your drive is now connected!
