NL in the 1981 All-Star game. After his 22 year playing
career, Bill served as the hitting coach for the Chicago
White Sox for two seasons.

JIM HORNER— Seattle Mariners

Jim has managed in the Seattle Mariners or-
ganization for the past four years. He earned Manager
of the year honors in the California League this past
season coaching the High Desert Mavericks. A former
Washington State standout, he caught for nine seasons in
