



## **Gender Inclusive Housing Application**

Gender Inclusive Housing (GIH) offers students the option for a room environment that is individualized, not one that is limited by the traditional gender binary. This is a voluntary option that allows students to choose to live with an individual of any gender identity regardless of their biological sex. Residents who opt into GIH will identify a roommate before being assigned housing, or they will turn this form in and will be matched with another person who is compatible, and who has also chosen GIH. Each person must turn in an individual application. Please note that GIH is not intended for couples in a romantic relationship who wish to live together.
