Art -Digital Video Instructor - Part-time

The Art Department at the College of Idaho invites applications for the position of part-time instructor of art to teach two courses in the spring of 2022 with the possibility for renewal thereafter.

The successful candidate would teach an introductory course in digital video that focuses on software, editing, and storytelling. Applicants must be proficient in using Adobe Premiere Pro. Some of the projects will include stop motion, mashup, and documentary film techniques. Students typically work with available tools (e.g. smart phones, Go Pro, and DSLR cameras).

The required qualifications are prior teaching experience and a Masters in an appropriate area of study or equivalent professional experience.

Candidates must be authorized to work in the United States as of the expected hire date and throughout the date of the contract without sponsorship from The College of Idaho.
