The ideal candidate will have a strong passion for teaching within an integrated liberal arts framework. A doctorate from an accredited institution is required; ABD will be considered so long as the degree will be completed by the time of appointment. Preference will be given to candidates with college teaching experience; industry experience is highly desirable.

Areas of Need: The College currently offers majors in business administration, marketing & digital media, and accounting. We seek a generalist with experience in teaching and research/scholarship who can fill <u>some</u> of the following teaching areas, listed in order of departmental need: Principles of Economics (micro & macro), Introduction to Business, Financial Accounting, Managerial Accounting, Social Entrepreneurship, Principles of Management, Principles of Finance, Legal Issues and Marketing. Responsibilities: This is a nine-month position, which will include flexibility in teaching undergraduate business courses. Typical course load is 3-1-3, (Fall, January term & Spring semester) or 21- 24 credits. Additional duties include academic advising, internship supervision, scholarship and service to the College and department. Professional development support for research, conference travel, and sabbatical leave are available.

- Doctorate from accredited institution required, with an emphasis in business, economics, management, entrepreneurship, marketing, business education, or related field is preferred
- College teaching experience required; industry experience highly desirable
- Commitment to undergraduate teaching in a liberal arts setting
- Collegiality, flexibility, and interest sufficient to work closely in a small department
- Innovation and adaptability in using technology to achieve learning outcomes
