- FYS-101 and Western Civilization (HIS-110, HIS-111 or HIS-112) and Liberal Arts Core requirements may not be taken as Pass/Fail.

*Note: The grade of P indicates any assigned grade of D- or above. Students should be aware that some postgraduate institutions may discount grade point average when P grades appear on the transcript.*
