Responsibilities include maintenance, care, and modification of the College's grounds and landscapes utilizing electrically-powered and gasoline-powered grounds keeping equipment and machines, the use of small hand and power tools or equipment in planting, cultivating, and trimming grounds and landscaping.

Principal Duties include:

- Perform all tasks common to the care of grounds and landscapes by seeding, watering, mulching, fertilizing, and applying chemicals to plants, trees, and lawns in a safe manner.
- Perform regular and directed grounds and landscape maintenance in a safe and undistracted manner by mowing lawns with riding or push mowers; trimming and edging around trees, shrubs, ground cover, flowers, sidewalks and buildings; weeding, thinning and cleaning flower beds and other grounds by hand or utilizing proper tools and equipment.
- Perform campus-wide general maintenance and repairs by installing, removing, repairing and maintaining parking lots, athletic fields, tennis courts, lighting, posts, fences, signs, cables, etc.
- Ensure that grounds maintenance equipment and building maintenance equipment are operational by performing routine and preventative maintenance and cleaning of tools, equipment and machines within reasonable capabilities.
- Assist in the inspection of irrigation systems, including all sprinklers, valves and controllers on a periodic basis and, as required, to ensure proper operations.
- Assist in the repairs and replacement of parts and components of the sprinkler systems.
- Prepare cost estimates for new and upgraded projects, equipment, and provide input to the Manager for budget requests.
- Perform building maintenance; clean roofs, gutters, downspouts and drains, plumbing repairs, replacing defective electrical switches, light bulbs, fuses, fluorescent ballasts, etc.
- Snow and/or ice removal, operating skid steer, golf carts, and other equipment with blades and using shovels to remove snow.
- Contribute to the overall success of the campus by performing all other related duties as assigned.

- Ability to follow the principles of safe work practices and adhere OSHA and safety standards.
