- Assist director in securing permits for use of Federal and State public lands.
- Ensure compliance with appropriate safety and risk management practices, liability policies and procedures, and emergency action plans laid out by Outdoor Program Director.
- Collaborate with the Marketing and Communications Department to generate marketing materials and enhance promotional efforts to reach College of Idaho faculty, staff, students, prospective students, alumni, and the local community.
- Actively participate in relevant professional associations, e.g. AORE and AEE.
- Complete other duties as assigned.
