AN ORDER

Allocating \$420.00 to the College of Idaho Student Affairs Department (Savala) for their purchase of a bus rental service which will provide transportation for students to and from Downtown Boise on October 20th as a test run to see if a more permanent transportation program can be established.

WHEREAS:

- I. The College of Idaho lacks transportation options for students without their own vehicles
- II. The single public bus system is not comprehensive enough for student's schedules
- III. This student led initiative is a test run to provide data on if the program has potential to grow
- IV. The contracts would be easy to establish, and the College already has a standing relationship with Caldwell Transportation Company
- V. This trip could open up other opportunities for clubs and organizations, increasing the Colleges relationship with CTC
- VI. A number of students have already agreed to supervise the event to provide liability coverage (EX: Make sure students aren't too rowdy)
- VII. The money will pay for one round-trip bus circuit to and from Downtown Boise.

THEREFORE:

Be it ordered by the ASCI Senate that \$420.00 be allocated to the Student Affairs Department (Savala). All receipts of purchases will be made available to the ASCI Treasurer or any ASCI Senator within one week of the expenditure, and any unused monies will be returned to the ASCI general account.
