**WHEREAS:**

- I. Several accessibility concerns have been brought before the ASCI Senate this term.
- II. The College is compliant with accessibility requirements under the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- III. Mere ADA compliance with federal and state law is insufficient to promote an inclusive, accessible, and diverse campus.
- IV. Inclusivity, accessibility, and diversity are values held by this college and its community.
- V. The Learning Support and Disabilities Center has outlined multiple areas on campus that are not accessible.
- VI. Accessibility is not an abstract issue. A lack of accessibility on campus affects real students every day.
- VII. This Senate has a duty to advocate for such affected students.
