Articulation Agreement: The College of Idaho and Community Colleges of Spokane

The C of I enrolls a number of students who began their academic pursuits at Community Colleges of Spokane. This articulation agreement is intended to facilitate a smooth transition for such students, as well as clarity of guidance for advising staff. A student transferring to C of I with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science-Transfer degree from the Community Colleges of Spokane will ordinarily receive the following:

- 1. Junior standing
- 2. Transfer credit of up to 106 quarter credits (70 semester credits)
- 3. Credit for completing much of the PEAK program

The PEAK curriculum at C of I requires students to complete at least one major and three minors. Community Colleges of Spokane transfers, however, who have completed the AA or AS-T degree will only be required to complete one major and one minor.

Students interested in pursuing majors in the sciences or social sciences should take Statistics as part of their Spokane program. Students interested in Business should also take Precalculus, Calculus for Business, or Calculus, as well as Micro and Macro Economics to streamline the completion of their baccalaureate degree.

The C of I will also accept Community Colleges of Spokane transfer students who have not completed their AA or AS-T degrees. The precise nature of their academic standing will be handled on an individual basis in accordance with the following guidelines:

Students who have earned 42-90 quarter credits (28-59 semester credits) will be required to complete a major and two PEAK minors.

Students who have earned fewer than 42 quarter credits (28 semester credits) will be expected to complete the full PEAK curriculum.

This agreement will be reviewed on a regular basis.
