

The Center for Experiential Learning (CEL) provides guidance on how you can assess your personal skill sets and evaluate how to express them both on paper and in-person by being guided through the *Career and Experiential Time Line*.

While all students have the opportunity work with a C of I career and experiential professional, and prepare for career and professional readiness, Junior Year is the starting point of learning how to begin to tie your academics and co-curricular experiences together to communicate your professional value to others.

## Suggested steps for successfully developing your professional profile include:

- 1. Meet at least 3 times with a CEL professional
  - Set personal career/professional goals
  - o Select support tools to work through in specific areas of interest to you
- 2. Attend at least 3 professional related programing events -Examples:
  - Coyote Connections
  - o Career Fair (Either C of I, BSU or NNU)
  - o Business Advisory Council Mentor Event
  - Resume/Career Workshops
  - Alumni Network Opportunity
  - Group session: THREADING it all together -How to prepare for the senior transition
- 3. Read and (group) meet to review suggested book
- 4. Produce a completed resume

<sup>\*</sup> Students who complete all four steps by end of senior year will be issued a certificate of professional preparedness.
