

Visiting Assistant Professor, Health and Human Performance

The <u>Department of Health and Human Performance</u> at the College of Idaho invites applications to fill a full-time Visiting Assistant Professor position for the 2020-2021 academic year. This is a 9-month contract which includes teaching 21 credits over two semesters and a 3-week January term.

The Department seeks candidates to complement existing faculty expertise in nutrition, strength and conditioning, physiology, sports psychology, and kinesiology. Candidates should have potential to teach some existing departmental courses and new coursework in area of expertise. Existing courses include Biomechanics, Motor Learning, Care and Prevention of Injuries, Anatomy and Physiology, Applied Nutrition, Exercise Metabolism, Cardiopulmonary Physiology, and Introduction to Exercise Science.

Excellent teaching and mentoring of students are the highest priorities of the College. The successful candidate will be an active scholar with a commitment to working closely with undergraduate students in a liberal arts college setting.

Qualifications:

- College teaching experience in relevant coursework.
- Doctoral degree completed by the beginning of Fall 2020 term in any field related to exercise science, including professional doctorates in physical therapy, athletic training, etc.
- Strength and conditioning certifications, personal training certifications, and/or coaching experience are highly desirable, but not necessary.

Please submit a cover letter, CV, statement of teaching philosophy, evidence of teaching effectiveness, statement of research interests, and 3 letters of recommendation.
