Qualifications: doctoral degree in biology, physiology, or related field with a cellular, molecular, or biomedical emphasis and commitment to undergraduate liberal arts education.

Applications should include a cover letter; CV; academic transcript(s); a statement of teaching philosophy that clearly articulates a commitment to liberal arts education and demonstrated commitment to representation, inclusion, and equity; and three letters of recommendation.
