

Winston Moore High Impact Practices Award

The Winston Moore High Impact Practices awards serve to help fund students' participation in Outdoor Program related high impact practices including study away programing, internships, independent study, student conferences and service learning. Students applying for funding are considered based financial need (defined by FAFSA standards) and the project being funded must be affiliated with an experience that will be registered for, or participated in, within the same academic year (i.e. pre-research during the summer that aligns to a fall independent study course).

Award Amount: up to \$2500 per applicant (students can only apply and receive funds once during their time at the C of I)
